BYLAW NO. 20-16 TOWN OF STRATHMORE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

THIS BY-LAW AUTHORIZES THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE TO PROVIDE A LOAN IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$23,000.00) TO THE STRATHMORE OVERNIGHT SHELTER.

**WHEREAS** the Strathmore Overnight Shelter desires to provide twenty-four-hour shelter service and staffing during the COVID-19 pandemic;

**AND WHEREAS** under the authority and the provisions of Section 264(2)(a) and 265 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Council has decided that the loan is of general benefit to the municipality.

**AND WHEREAS** the Strathmore Overnight Shelter requires twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000.00) for working capital for operations of the shelter;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

#### **PURPOSE**

1. The purpose of this bylaw is to provide a loan of twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000.00) from the Town of Strathmore to the Strathmore Overnight Shelter pursuant to Sections 264(2)(a) and 265 of the *Municipal Government Act* for the provision of working capital during the COVID-19 pandemic.

## INTERPRETATION

- 2. In this bylaw:
  - (a) "Town" means the Town of Strathmore, a municipal corporation in the Province of Alberta.
  - (b) "Loan" means the lending of funds from the Town of Strathmore to the Strathmore Overnight Shelter as authorized by this bylaw.

#### THE LOAN

- 3. The Town shall lend twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000.00) at CIBC prime interest rate to the Strathmore Overnight Shelter for the sole purpose of providing working capital for staffing of the shelter.
- 4. Such loan authorization is made on the condition that the Strathmore Overnight Shelter enter into a loan agreement with the Town of Strathmore that is satisfactory in form and content to the Town or its authorized agents for a period of up to ninety (90) days after which time it shall be come due and payable.

## EFFECTIVE DATE

This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the date of third and final reading.

READ A FIRST TIME this 17<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020.

READ A SECOND TIME this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2020.

READ A THIRD TIME this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2020.
