## **BYLAW NO. 25-15** OF THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

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### A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING **COUNCIL PROCEDURE BYLAW NO. 23-17.**

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, Council may pass bylaws in relation to the procedures to be followed by Council and its committees;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to establish rules and provisions to regulate how Council Meetings and Committee of the Whole Meetings are conducted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Municipal Council of the Town of Strathmore, duly assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

#### 1. TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Council Procedure Bylaw Amending Bylaw No. 25-15".

#### 2. **PURPOSE**

2.1. That Section 12.14 be added to Bylaw 23-17 to state:

> "12.14 Members of the Public must register with Legislative Services by 12 p.m. on the day that the Public Hearing is held if they wish to participate in the public hearing virtually. Should the attendee lose connectivity during the public hearing, Council may call a recess to allow the attendee to rejoin the meeting."

#### 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**

3.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon receiving third and final reading and being signed.

READ a first time this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2025.

READ a second time this 30th day of April, 2025.
