Terms and Conditions

1. TOWN OF STRATHMORE REPRESENTATIVE ONLY MAY OPEN AND CLOSE HYDRANTS. Any damage caused by mishandling or mismanagement of the hydrant will be charged against the user.
2. This being a legal and binding contract between the lessor and the town of Strathmore, IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LESSOR TO CONTACT THE CITY AND REQUEST A RETRIEVAL APPOINTMENT ONCE THE USE OF THE HYDRANT IS COMPLETED. Failure to do so does not remove the lessor from any damage or tampering liabilities while the contract is still active.
3. Total security deposit of \$2,552.54 is required with every hydrant meter rental. This deposit comprises of \$2,370.00 (contributes to total rental and end water consumption) + \$150.00 (installation fee) + \$32.54 (administration fee).
4. Rental fees are \$8.00/day, \$50.00/week, and \$170.00/month.
5. Any relocation requests after initial set up incurs a fee of \$150.00/hour for every relocation request thereafter (over & above all other fees).
6. Water consumption will be metered at the current approved Strathmore Fees Bylaw rate for Bulk Water.
7. Total water consumption will be estimated in a scenario where the water meter fails to register.
8. Applicant accepts responsibility for protecting meter, hydrant & all equipment from frost and vandalism. The applicant is responsible for the cost of repair or replacement of the unit if damaged or stolen.
9. Applicant accepts responsibility for any damages to the Town of Strathmore equipment and/or roads.
10. Applicant agrees to provide warning signs and traffic barricades at all times.
11. Applicant agrees to provide a flagman, if required, for vehicle traffic safety.
12. Town of Strathmore reserves the right to discontinue the water supply at any time without notice if the use is causing a disturbance to the water system and surrounding Private or Town-owned property.
13. Contractor must provide Town of Strathmore with a list of preferred hydrant locations. The final selection will be at the discretion of the Town of Strathmore or the Representative.
14. Hydrant rental season commences APRIL 1st to OCTOBER 31st - weather permitting. All hydrant meters must be retrieved and returned to the Town of Strathmore on or before October 31st. Extensions outside of these parameters are at the discretion and approval of the Town of Strathmore with consent and agreement from the applicant to winterize and protect hydrant, meter, backflow, and all pertaining Town equipment.
