**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
TO AMEND THE WATER UTILITY BYLAW NO. 18-06**

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000* and amendments thereto provides authority for the Town to regulate such matters;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Municipal Council of the Town of Strathmore, in the Province of Alberta duly assembled **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

8.1 A Person requesting Town Water Service must submit an application for same to the Town together with the fee, as listed in Bylaw 13-21 Fees Bylaw, and any applicable security required by Council;

**Section 19.1**

19.1 A Person must submit an application and pay the applicable fees, as listed in Bylaw No. 13-21 Fees Bylaw.


