

BYLAW NO. 21-06 TOWN OF STRATHMORE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE PARKS AND PATHWAYS BYLAW NO. 14-07.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Strathmore deems it desirable to allow for public use of designated storm ponds;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Strathmore deems it desirable to allow public access to pathways twenty-four (24) hours a day;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000 C. M-26 empowers Councils to pass bylaws

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Municipal Council of the Town of Strathmore duly assembled **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

100. AMENDMENTS

That the following sections of the Parks and Pathways Bylaw No. 14-07 be amended as follows:

Amend:

Section 2(k):

"Parks" means a public space owned and/or operated by the Town and set aside as a Park to be used for rest, recreation, exercise, pleasure, amusement and enjoyment and includes:

- (i) Playgrounds;
- (ii) Cemeteries:
- (iii) Natural Areas;
- (iv) Sports Fields;
- (v) Pathways;
- (vi) Water Spray Parks;

- (vii) Green spaces
- (viii) Skate Parks
- (ix) Trails:
- (x) Park Roadways; and
- (xi) Storm Water Ponds;

But does not include golf courses

Section 4:

(3) Despite subsection (1) all pathways are open twenty-four (24) hours a day.

Rescind:

Section 16:

No Person shall launch a boat, canoe, kayak or similar craft or within a Park except where specifically allowed by the CAO.
