Trees and landscaping are a great way to add beauty to our Town. Planting Trees is also a great way to reduce our environmental footprint. They clean the air, reduce storm water runoff, provide habitat for birds and wildlife, all while enhancing the urban landscape. Planting trees in all new developments, along streets and boulevards benefits property owners by providing shade and atmosphere which can increase property values.

The Town of Strathmore has a special climate and growing conditions that offer challenges when it comes to selecting tree varieties that will thrive in our area. To help you out we have compiled a list of specific species as examples of trees and shrubs that grow well in Strathmore.

Developers and Builders

The Town's Land Use Bylaw also provides requirements on general site landscaping for new developments. These include requirements for soft landscaping, hard landscaping, screening and buffering of parking lots, landscaping securities, and minimum requirements for tree size and types. All applicants are encouraged to review the Town's Land Use Bylaw requirements in conjunction with this brochure prior to submitting development permit applications.
